The Registration Form must be completed and returned to the Registrar with the registration fee of £120.00 (incl. VAT) before a child may be considered for a place in the School. The registration fee is non refundable. On acceptance of a place, parents are required to pay a deposit of £13,880.00. No further registration fee is required for transfer to other departments in the School i.e. Sixth Form. Parents are liable for School Fees when a place has been accepted and an Acceptance Form completed.

The deposit is returned when the pupil leaves the School. If a pupil accepts a place but does not join the School the deposit is retained and is non-refundable.

Scholarships & Bursaries

All applicants at 11 + are automatically considered for an academic scholarship based on their performance in the entrance examination. If you would like to apply for other scholarships or a bursary please tick the relevant boxes below.

rts Scholarship

Candidates for an 11+ Sports Scholarship are expected to demonstrate all-round ability in a number of sports and be motivated to participate in school teams and compete regularly and enthusiastically for the school. They must demonstrate a high level of fitness, as well as a particular ability in at least one of the core sports on the assessment day including football, netball, swimming and athletics. Each candidate must submit a personal statement outlining their current sporting endeavours and achievements, detailing the level that they are playing for <u>each</u> sport eg. school or regional team, county level qualification etc. You must also attach a recommendation from your child's coach, club or school. Once an application is received the Head of Sport will assess their ability and eligibility, and successful candidates will be invited for an assessment morning. During the assessment morning the Head of Sport will choose a shortlist of candidates who will be invited back for interview and they will be expected to show evidence of their ability and commitment to fulfil

the role of a Sports Scholar.

Music Scholarship

Candidates for an 11+ Music Scholarship are expected to perform on at least two instruments. Candidates should be a minimum of Grade 4 on their first instrument and be able to show skill and technique in their second instrument. Once an application is received the Head of Music will assess their ability and eligibility, and successful candidates will be invited for audition. This consists of a prepared piece and sight-reading on their first instrument, a prepared piece on their second instrument, and aural tests for musicianship. There will also be an interview with the Head and the Head of Music. You must also attach a recommendation from your child's Music Teacher or other professionally qualified person. Music Scholars are expected to involve themselves fully in the musical life of the School, and it is likely that they will study Music at GCSE level.

Creative Arts Exhibition Award

Creative Arts Exhibition Awards Exhibition Awards may be given at the Head's discretion to anyone who shows outstanding talent and commitment to Art, Drama or Dance. Students can demonstrate their talent and commitment by a portfolio of work (Art), LAMDA exams (Drama), recorded evidence of performance ability (Drama/Dance), examples of semi-professional or professional work, e.g Youth Theatre, Youth Dance, local or West End performances or success at local, national or international competitions Other evidence may be considered. Applications should be made in writing to the Head of Creative & Performing Arts.

Bursary

Admission Requirements

Registration Forms are accepted on the understanding that pupils will not be offered a place until they have passed Farringtons School's entry requirements.

Early Years: All Pre-Reception and Reception applicants will be required to undertake an age appropriate assessment/taster session and provide a copy of their Healthy Child Programme Two Year Progress Review.

Junior Department: All Junior Department applicants will be required to spend a day in school with their year group and will be assessed in Literacy and Numeracy. External applicants must have a reference and report from their current school.

Senior Department: Year 7 – A Year 7 Entrance Examination is held in the Autumn Term prior to transfer. External applicants must have a reference and report from their current school and will be interviewed.

Senior Department: Year 8 – 10 – Entrance papers must be taken for entry to any part of the Senior School, together with an interview. These papers are taken at Farringtons, but may, exceptionally, be taken at a pupil's current school with their agreement. A report and reference from an applicant's current school will be sought.

Sixth Form: Admission to particular courses will depend upon availability of places and a student's prior attainment at GCSE. Our policy is to ensure that students accepted into the Sixth Form can be placed in appropriate courses where they are likely to succeed.

The minimum entry requirement is five GCSEs at Level 4 or above including English and Maths, usually with a grade 5–6 in the subjects to be studied. External applicants must have a reference from their current school and complete a Sixth Form Application Form. They will also be interviewed by a senior member of staff.

The school reserves the right to use its discretion, based on the school's knowledge of that applicant, to offer a place or suggest an alternative subject option. A full copy of our Sixth Form Admissions Policy is available on request from the Registrar.
